Art. 14 LAA

legal clinics are authorised to

provide **general legal**

information and legal advice;

they may also **draft submissions**

authorised to provide legal aid

also outside of the legal aid

system, on funding independent

from the state

- Legal Curriculum

part of the study programme in IX

semester (10 ECTS)

students may provide all permitted

forms of legal aid

LC may not represent in court, but may

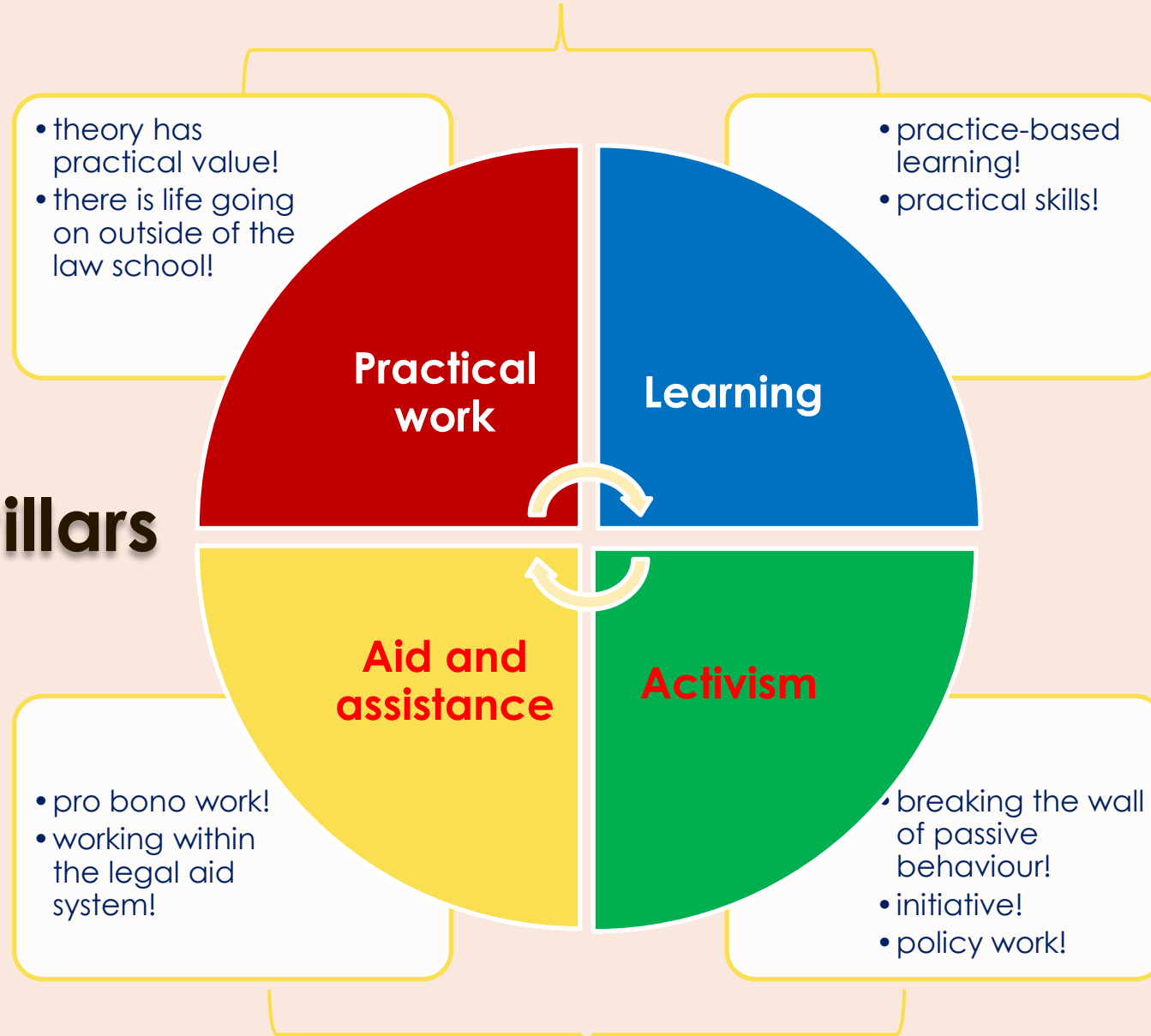
assist the lawyers

the law school, make partnerships

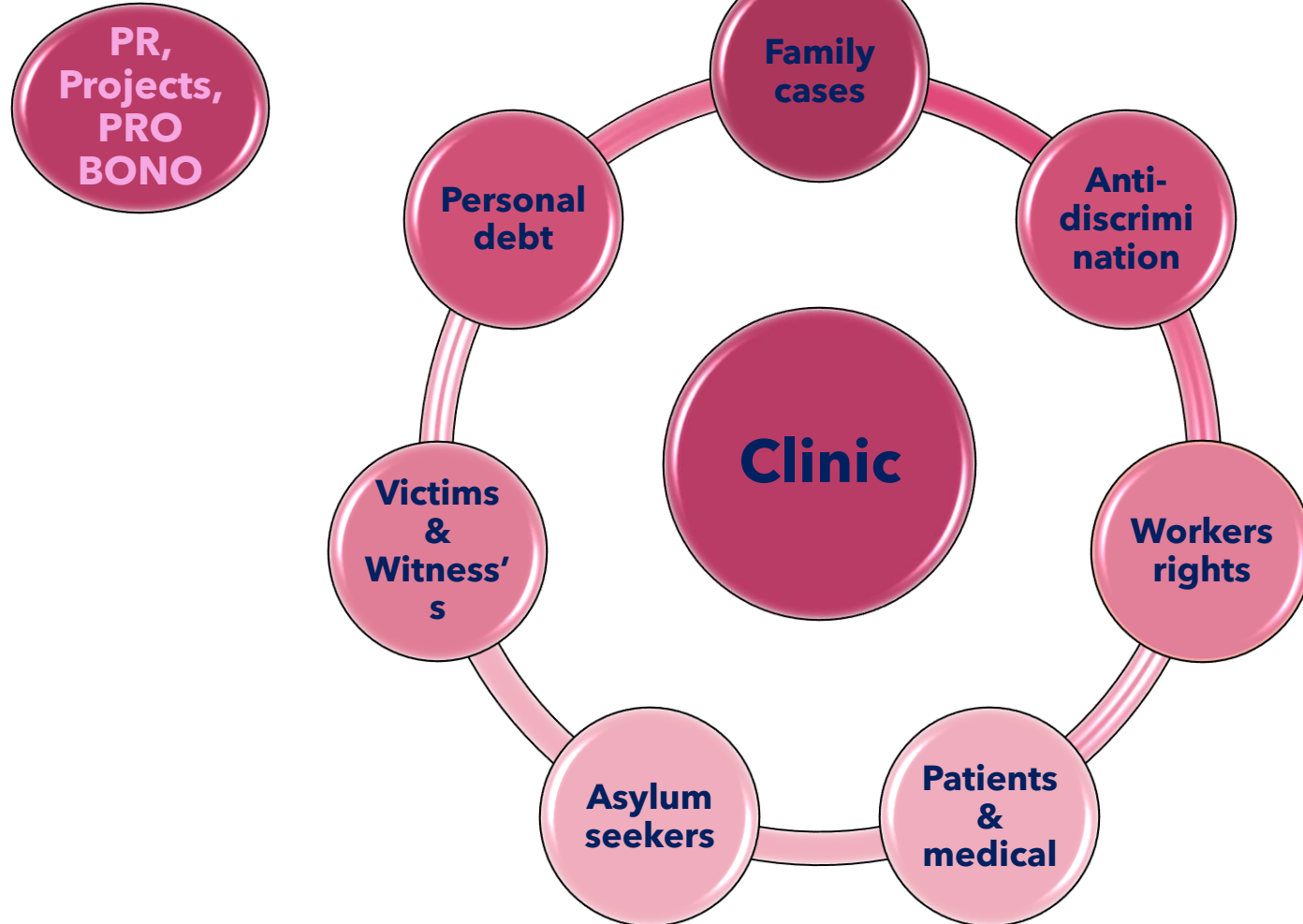

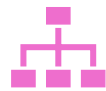
